





- Suggestion: first download and fill-out the two-pager template
- Then: download the full application documents and complete them
- Submit by 24.10., midnight • (23.59h)

Selection



- Tender Opening Board: checking formalities and "space connection"

- Announcement of winners: before 10.11.2016




